

A FEW IMPORTANT DETAILS FROM THE AAFSC OFFICE - SPRING 2011

All Skaters are **REQUIRED** to check in with Ice Monitor/PIC prior to entering the ice. Those not contracting should be prepared to provide payment prior to entering the ice. Skaters **must be** members of AAFSC to skate on Club sessions. A non-AAFSC United States Figure Skating member may skate up to **three** times before having to join AAFSC as a 2nd Club member. Proof of USFS membership and a fully completed and signed AAFSC waiver are required.

- ✓ **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Skaters **must pay** for the session PRIOR to entering the ice. All Club sessions will have a PIC (Person-in-charge) or Ice Monitor who collects money at the ice entrance and then moves to the Music Booth to play music and monitor the ice. If the skater enters the ice late, he/she **MUST** go directly to the Music Booth (even if they are late for a lesson) to check in and pay for their ice. PIC will only accept cash (no bills higher than \$20 please), checks (made out to AAFSC) or Sign-On cards. If there is no ice monitor, payment must be made in the AAFSC office prior to entering the ice. Skaters without payment, contract or Sign-On Cards will NOT be allowed on the ice.

SCHEDULE CHANGES:

We'd like to call your attention to a few changes in the 2011 Spring Ice Schedule that differ from past Fall & Winter.

- ✓ Monday at 7:15pm (Session #207) – This is a new 50 minute High Synchro Skating Skills class that will be run in conjunction with the General Session(#206). This change was made to increase the use of a poorly attended session that has been a significant financial loss to the club and provide high synchro skills instruction. Class limited to 18 skaters by contract only.
- ✓ Wednesday 5:15 thru 6:35pm (Sessions 404, 405 & 406) – Skaters have the option to contract or sign-on for 80 minutes, 50 minutes or 30 minutes. There will be NO ice make at 6:05, so there is NO ten minute break.
- ✓ Saturday at 9:15am (Session #700) – We implemented a combined Shooting Stars/General Session during the Winter and have kept this for the Spring.
- ✓ Saturday at 11:15am (Session #704) – LTS for Snow Plow Sam to Basic 3 beginners. Due to the large number of lower level Basic Skills skaters on Tuesday and Thursday nights as well as at 10:15 Saturday morning this second Saturday LTS session has been added.
- ✓ Saturday at 12:15pm – This has been eliminated as a General Session. Synchro practice formerly held at 11:15 has been moved into this slot.

CLEANLINESS:

It is very important that everyone work to keep our environment neat, clean and healthy. This includes locker rooms, ice rinks and café areas. Please do not leave food, tissues, tights, guards or “anything” just lying around and please do not write on lockers or on any surfaces in the locker room. You are a guest in someone else's home. Be on your BEST behavior.

THEFT:

Please !! Do not leave items of value lying around. Ipods, cellphones, jackets, purses, books, money and even skates have been stolen from the rink as well as the AAFSC Locker Room. If you value your possessions please do NOT leave them unattended. If you are taking things that do not belong to you, **STOP!**

Your possessions should be locked in your locker at all times, even when you are on the ice. If you do not have a locker see Joan in the AAFSC office or use the coin-operated lockers in the downstairs lobby. Do NOT leave your bags or coats on the locker room benches at any time unattended. Bags have been opened and contents removed or stolen. Lockers should be locked at all times, NEVER left open for someone else to use or so you don't have to open them again later.

Theft and other incidents should be reported to the AAFSC office immediately along with details such as day, time and witnesses. We need your help and cooperation in making the Club Locker Room theft-free.
